A VICTORY ON THE PRAYER ISSUE

Recently in Cobb County Georgia a federal judge ruled that the pervasive use of sectarian prayer was acceptable. The board of commissioners had invited a cross section of clergy to participate in their prayer exercise. A lawyer for Cobb County Georgia stated after the victory; "We won every single inning, every single at-bat in the case." When playing on a level playing field there is no contest between the un-American philosophy of the ACLU and the true values of Americanism.

STREET PREACHING TO BE CENSORED

Pastor Mark Smith and the Baux Mountain Baptist Church have shared the gospel with the people of Walnut Cove North Carolina for an extended period of time. The city council has passed an ordinance limiting their ability to exercise their First Amendment rights. The ordinance will require a group of three or more person wishing to assemble for any reason to submit an application 60 days in advance of the date of the planned demonstration and to pay an application fee of \$30.00. A permit will only be issued to any one group four times per year. The ordinance is the result of The Baux Mountain Baptist Church handing out literature and preaching on the streets of Walnut Cove. Some members of the City Council made disparaging remarks toward Baux Mountain Baptist Church. Return America continues to work alongside Pastor Smith and has been in contact with Gibbs Law Firm. Letters both to the City Manager and City Attorney are forthcoming. Please pray for Pastor Smith and the Baux Mountain Baptist Church as they seek to carry out the great commission without censorship.
