A LOOK BACK

Did our forefathers believe that prayer in a Government setting was an establishment of religion? History does not reveal that our delegates went to the Constitutional Convention with the intent of separating church and state. These men were selected not because they were brilliant politicians but because they had the combined quality of religion and government in view. For the first 150 years of our history strong Christian commitment was a vital part of their thinking. (History records this)

The question of: "What is an establishment of religion" was questioned and addressed on March 27, 1854. From the House Committee on the Judiciary comes a man by the name of Mr. Meacham who gave the following report: "What is an establishment of religion? It must have a creed, defining what a man must believe; it must have rites and ordinances, which believers must observe; it must have ministers of defined qualifications, to teach the doctrines and administer the rites; it must have tests for the submissive and penalties for the non-conformist. There never was an established religion without all these--"¹
