TO ALL OF OUR RETURN AMERICA FRIENDS

A few weeks ago people from all over North Carolina sent a strong signal to our leadership in Raleigh that we want a Marriage Amendment to our State Constitution. We asked you to contact the leadership and express your feelings that the Marriage Amendment should be brought out of committee and voted upon. Many of you have forwarded Mr. Basnights responses to me. I would like to clarify some of the rhetoric he shared with you.

Mr. Basnigh mentions a law passed in 1871 which defined marriage as between one man and one woman. He then mentions the Defense Of Marriage Act which he supported in 1996. And then he said; "North Carolina's marriage laws have withstood challenge for more than 130 years, and are not at risk of being overturned."

MY OBSERVATION

Simply stated Mr. Basnigh is not particularly honest with you. **One liberal judge can overturn the laws he mentions.**

1. How does he know that they are not at risk of being overturned. He is not omnipotent and does not know the plans of those who oppose Traditional Marriage. Those opposed to Traditional Marriage could oppose our present laws at any time and with the help of a liberal judge overturn them.
2. I find it ironic that in 1996 he did not believe the 1871 law sufficient and voted to strengthen it. Maybe he should again use the same mind set.

Mr. Basnigh again states, "The Constitution should only be amended to address situations where law alone do not suffice."

Again, I find this statement ludicrous. Mr. Basnigh should know that the present marriage laws will not "suffice should the wrong judge rule. Thus, he answered his own question.
